Whereas, the County of Fayette seeks to upgrade its existing wastewater facilities; and

Whereas, the County of Fayette intends to apply for Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for the planning, design and or construction of the wastewater facilities; and

Whereas, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Fayette County Board of Commissioners of the County Fayette, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Fayette County Board of Commissioners be and is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF loan, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for planning, design and/or construction of wastewater facilities on behalf of County of Fayette, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the dedicated source of repayment for the construction loan will be user fees.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LOCAL JAIL CAPITAL PROJECT GRANT AGREEMENT WITH RESPECT TO THE FAYETTE JAIL FACILITY

Mr. Dean offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Fayette (the "Board") desires to enter into a LOCAL JAIL CAPITAL PROJECT AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), with the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (the "Department") concerning the Fayette County Jail Facility in the County (the "Project") in accordance with the terms hereof and the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board as follows:

Section 1. Any two members of the Board of County Commissioners of the County are authorized and directed to execute and deliver, in the name and on behalf of the County, the Amendment, in substantially the form submitted to and now on file with the County, which is hereby approved, with such changes therein not inconsistent with this Resolution as may be approved by such members of the Board. The approval of such changes by this Board shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the Amendment by such County Commissioners.

Section 2. Each member of the Board and other county officials are each separately authorized to take any and all actions and to execute such certificates and other instruments as may be necessary or appropriate in order to affect the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and, to the extent inconsistent therewith, supersedes any prior resolution of this Board.
