BIDS TO BE RECEIVED – FAYETTE COUNTY PAVING PROGRAM

It was moved by Mr. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Garland that Steve Luebbe, County Engineer, be authorized to advertise to receive bids on February 1, 2021 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioners' office for the Fayette County Paving Program. Engineer's estimate: \$997,266.506. Advertising date: January 8, 2021. The Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids. Roll call: Mr. Dean, aye; Mr. Garland, aye; Mr. Anderson, aye. Motion carried.

BIDS TO BE RECEIVED – FAYETTE COUNTY CHIP SEAL PROGRAM

It was moved by Mr. Garland and seconded by Mr. Anderson that Steve Luebbe, County Engineer, be authorized to advertise to receive bids on February 1, 2021 at 10:15 A.M. in the Commissioners' office for the Fayette County Chip Seal Program. Engineer's estimate: \$141,184.85. Advertising date: January 8, 2021. The Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids. Roll call: Mr. Dean, aye; Mr. Garland, aye; Mr. Anderson, aye. Motion carried.

CONTRACT – VILLAGE OF OCTA, LAW ENFORCEMENT

It was moved by Mr. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Garland to authorize the Sheriff to enter into contract with the Village of Octa to provide law enforcement services to keep the peace, to protect the property and to perform other necessary police functions in the Village through the office of the Fayette County Sheriff for the year 2021. The Village, at the direction of the Mayor, reserves the privilege of requesting additional law enforcement services, beyond those provided by the Sheriff in keeping the peace of said Village. The Village agrees to pay the Sheriff the sum of \$25.00 per hour for services rendered. (Original agreement on file.) Roll call: Mr. Dean, aye; Mr. Garland, aye; Mr. Anderson, aye. Motion carried.

CONTRACT – COMMERCIAL CLEANING SOLUTIONS, INC., JANITORIAL SERVICES, FAYETTE COUNTY ADULT DETENTION FACILITY

It was moved by Mr. Garland and seconded by Mr. Anderson, to enter into contract with Commercial Cleaning Solutions, Inc., 10965 St. Rt. 138, Greenfield, 45123 for janitorial services at the Fayette County Adult Detention Facility for an initial one year term for a sum of \$27,300.00, commencing January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021. The County shall have the option, but not the obligation, to extend the contract for an additional two years upon the same terms and conditions, and upon notifying Contractor not less than thirty (30) days prior to the end of the initial term hereof. CONTRACT – CENTRAL OHIO AREA AGENCY ON AGING OF THE COLUMBUS RECREATION AND PARKS DEPARTMENT, FY2021 TITLE III/SCSBG FUNDS

It was moved by Mr. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Garland to enter into contract with the Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging of the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department for FY2021 Title III/SCSBG funds including Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) and Senior Community Services Block Grant (SCSBG) funds. Contract amount shall be \$115,710.00 unless modified by the COAAA. Contact Period: The period of time covered by this contract shall be January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021. PROPOSED QUOTE ACCEPTED - WELLER'S PLUMBING & HEATING, FAYETTE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

It was moved by Mr. Garland and seconded by Mr. Anderson to accept the quote from Weller's Plumbing & Heating, 429 S. Washington Street, Greenfield, 45123 for the removal of faulty compressors (CU#2, CU#4 and CU#6) and install new compressors at the Fayette County Courthouse. The total cost of quote is \$10,750.00. STAFFING AGREEMENT – JAMES MICHAEL McWEENEY, M.D., dba McCLURE EMERGENCY CONSULTANTS, LLC (DR. McWEENEY), FAYETTE COUNTY JAIL

It was moved by Mr. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Garland, per the request of Sheriff Vernon Stanforth, to enter into an agreement with Dr. James Michael McWeeney, M.D., to provide physician services to the inmates of the Fayette County Jail for an annual fee of \$31,200.00 paid in twelve equal monthly installments of \$2,600.00. The County will pay for CORSA malpractice insurance for Dr. McWeeney to provide physician services to the County. Term of the agreement is for one year commencing on January 1, 2021 and terminating on December 31, 2021. Either party may terminate this agreement early by giving thirty days written notice to the other party of such termination. Roll call: Mr. Dean, aye; Mr. Garland, aye; Mr. Anderson, aye.
